## About Elimination of Extreme Poverty in Bangladesh (EEP)

Islamic Relief Bangladesh has been implementing the Elimination of Extreme Poverty in Bangladesh (EEP) project at Rajarhat and Kurigram Sadar sub-districts, in Kurigram, the most poverty-stricken district in Bangladesh with the funding of Islamic Relief UK. EEP is an integrated model which includes various essential components for an impactful development aiming at eliminating extreme poverty. The scaling-up EEP project will support 6,000 extreme poor and marginalized households (25,113 household members) through 240 SHGs and 40,000 wider community people through various socio-economic actions in the context of extreme poverty and vulnerability, food and livelihood insecurity, and socio-economic exclusion.

### **PROJECT OUTCOMES**

Outcome 1: Targeted 6000 Households have been lifted out of multidimensional extreme poverty with increased income and food security through implementation of EEP model.

- 1.1: Targeted 6000 Households have improved knowledge and capacity on diversified income generating activities (IGAs), health, hygiene, food & nutrition security and social issues.
- 1.2: Enhanced engagement of targeted 6000 HHs in sustainable income generating activities.
- 1.3: Targeted Households are aware of rights & entitlements, social safety net and other government and non-government services.

Outcome 2: Enhanced sustainable financial inclusion and social empowerment of the targeted families and communities through community led collective action

- 2.1: 240 Self-Help Groups established and capacitated to support economic and social empowerment initiatives.
- Community based interest free sustainable financial services generated, managed & mobilized by Self-Help Groups (SHGs) and Apex bodies.
- 2.3: Apex bodies and NCN (National Cooperative Network - federation of Apex bodies) are capacitated to continue the EEP model.

Outcome 3: Relevant government departments and national & international development partners are sensitized and capacitated for replication of EEP model.

- 3.1: Development practitioners from wider national and international organizations are capacitated to replicate EEP model.
- 3.2: Relevant government departments and national & international development partners are sensitized on EEP model.

### **Increased income and Food Security**

- Selection of 6000 extreme poor and destitute families
- Analyze livelihood choice options & opportunities and skills & capacities of the HHs extreme poor and destitute families
- · Prepare business plan
- · Facilitate IGA training and Hands-on training
- Provide cash for productive means
- Establish Community based food bank
- Distribute vegetable seeds and climate friendly fruit sapling support
- Provide subsistence allowance for most vulnerable households
- Anticipatory action for DRR fund for any emergency

### Financial inclusion and Social empowerment

- Form 240 SHGs comprising of the selected 6000 households
- Form Apex body of the SHGs
- Capacity building training of SHGs and Apex body leaders
- Provide intensive training to women groups on Islamic Financial System
- · Initiate group-led savings mobilization
- Establish group-led revolving fund management systems
- Introduce Islamic Shariah-based Qard-al-Hasana/ Financing
- Linkage build up with National Cooperative Network (NCN)

### Sensitized and Capacitated of national and international partners on EEP model

- Organize workshop and seminar and coordination meeting on EEP
- Organize training for development practitioners on EEP Model
