

PROJECT OVERVIEW

With the funding of Islamic Relief Belgium, IR Bangladesh has been implementing a 24-months long "Strengthening Ultra-Poor Women's capacity and increasing incomes for Food and Livelihood Security (SUFOL)" project aims to enhance economic sustainability and reduce vulnerabilities in Thakurgaon Sadar, Thakurgaon. The project targets extreme poor, women & men agricultural daily labourer, female-headed HHs, widow, divorced, abandoned women, HHs having disabled person, child labour-depended HHs and socio-economically excluded persons will be given priority & focusing on economic, social, and skill development to build resilience and elevate social dignity. It promotes community-led, women-group based interest-free financial services to foster financial inclusion and empowerment. Additionally, the project seeks to establish linkages with various service providers to enhance access to essential services. Ultimately, the SUFOL project envisions transforming the socioeconomic landscape of northern Bangladesh, making communities economically self-reliant and socially dignified.
